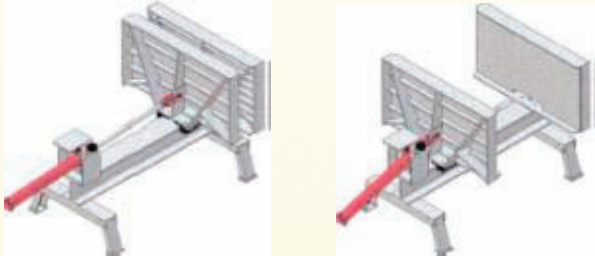
Roots of Generosity
